

PunchLine: How to Play

1. The aim of the game is to read out the jokes on the joke cards, but there is a twist. In the game there is an audience, and the audience is determined by the cards that are faced up on the field.
2. At the start of the game each player should draw 5 joke cards.
3. Then 4 Audience cards should be drawn and played down on the field, two faced up and two faced down.
4. Both players need to select a joke and read it out loud, once the card has been read the player should then check the subject of the card and compare them to the subjects of the Audience cards and do any of the required calculations to determine how good of a reaction the joke got. Each joke starts with a score of 5 and will either go higher or lower based on the Audience cards.
5. The player whose joke scored highest on that round then obtains a point.
6. Once a joke card has been played a new joke card will then be picked up so that each player has five joke cards each at any given time.
7. The two Audience cards that were face up are then discarded from the game and the two face down now become face up and two new Audience cards are drawn and placed face down.
8. The game is then played until you run out of Audience cards or joke cards.
9. The player with the most points is then declared the winner of the game.
