

Target audience: Teen and up

Number of players: 4+

1. Take controversy card

1.5. If you think your card is just too much for you, once per turn, you can shuffle your card back in and draw a new one, but then you'll be stuck with it!

2. Explain your candidate's actions or "fix" their quote for the public

3. Take a poll. After your statement, how many voters are on your side?

3.5. It's up to each person how they want to vote, whether it's based on the cleverness of the defense, or if the defense is actually agreeable. You can vote for as many or as few people as you want!

4. After 3-5 rounds, each player's votes from each round are counted and whoever has the most votes total wins

During Teleprompter off, one person has to make a controversial statement or describe a controversial action and the person in the turn order must attempt to "fix" it.

- If more than half of the voters approve of the translated statement, then the PR player gets double the votes of that turn
- If less than half the voters approve the translated statement, the controversial player gets votes equal to the number of players automatically
- Depending on the player count, it's up to each individual game who should get the votes if the translated statement has exactly half the votes

Alt ruleset:

Remove **[TELEPROMPTER]** cards. Instead of voting for as many or as few players as you want, at the end of each round, everyone has 1 vote they can put towards their favorite defense, and whoever has the most votes wins. You can't vote for yourself and you only get one vote, so use it wisely!
